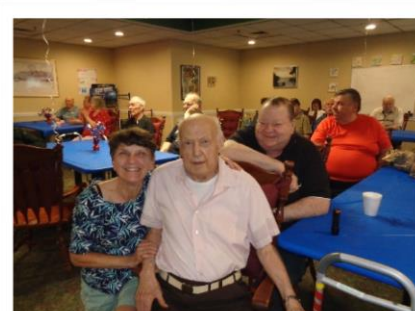
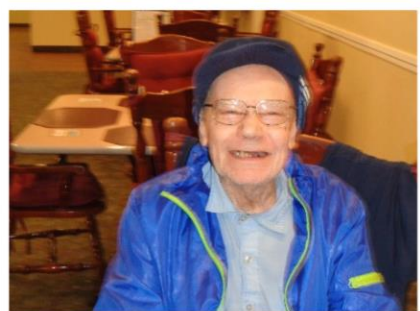

# About Our Organization

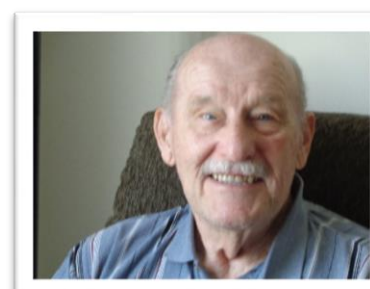
