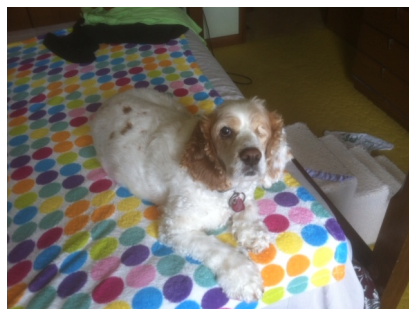
Featured Resident of the Month Bob Ortel
