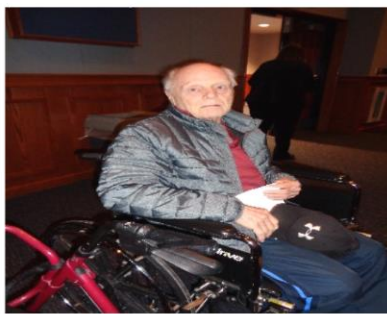

About Our Organization

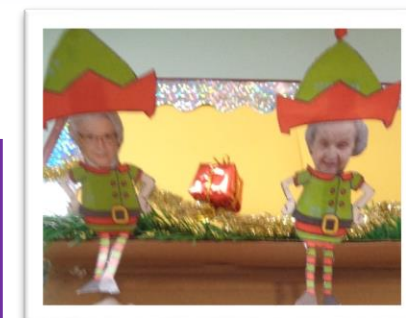
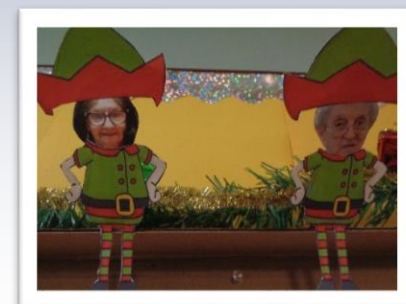
