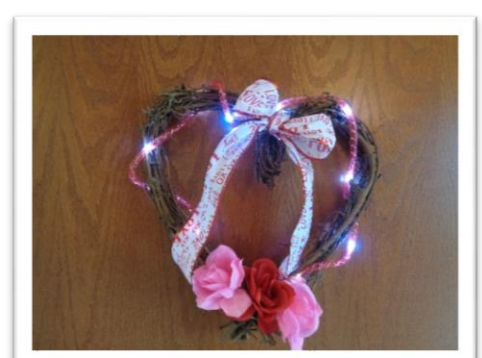


FEATURED RESIDENT: Ann Golbert

About Our Organization

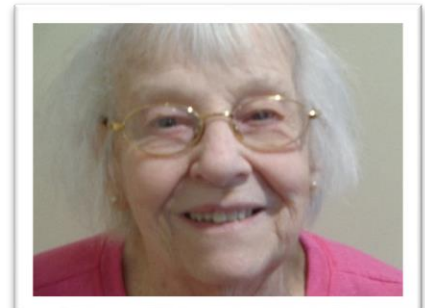
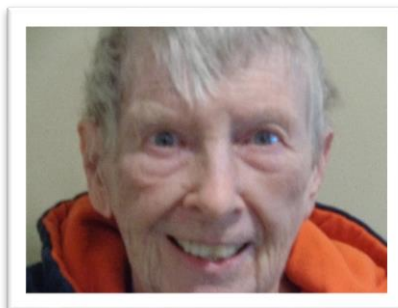
