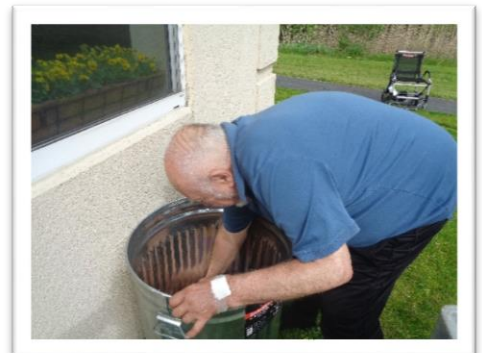
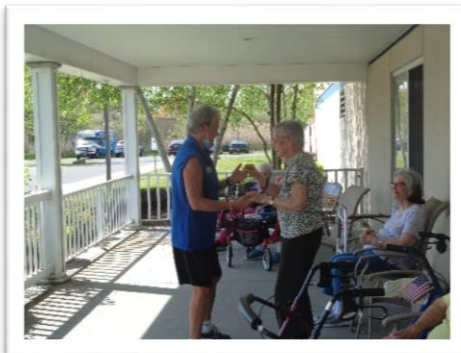
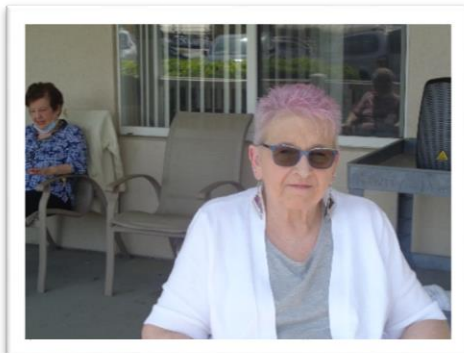


FEATURED RESIDENT: Bob Jagiello

About Our Organization

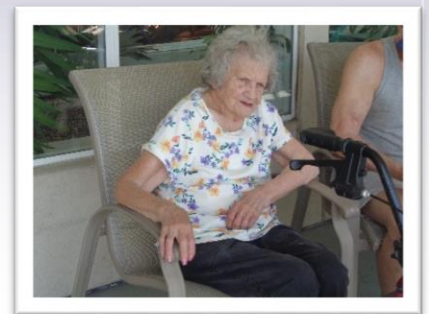
